Minutes of the last meeting

These had been circulated to the group via email. They were approved by the members present and signed by Dr. Moloughney.

Matters Arising not on the Agenda

- (a) **Footpath** – MF is still trying to arrange a meeting with Councillor Daren Pemberton. However, the footpaths were mentioned in the recent Bidford Parish “Enhancing Community Facilities in Bidford consultation” published on the Bidford Parish Website “Notice 26/4/19”.
- (b) **The Ideas Factory** – The above mentioned Report also made reference to the ways various Bidford groups communicate with the local people. They are looking at linking in with Facebook and Twitter. There is no co-ordination between the different groups. There also needs to be more emphasis on physical activities. Young people’s health issues were also mentioned.
- (c) **Walking Group** – No further developments at present. There are national walking schemes available one of which runs in Bidford every Monday morning at 10 am from the Bridge. Anyone interested just turns up and joins the group. A copy of details from the Abbey Medical Centre, Kenilworth are attached to these Minutes and were previously circulated.
- (d) **Recruitment to PPG** – We continue to work on this and the surgery were recently asked to include some questions on their recent GP Patient Survey. We are waiting for the results. Copy of the Survey attached to these Minutes.
- (e) **Bidford EMAIL** - WL reported that Bidford Parish Council will send out an email to local residents (or others) who wish to be included in the information email list and receive weekly information of what is happening in the village/parish as well as notices etc. Due to GDPR the Parish Clerk needs to receive an official request in order for this to happen. See the Bidford Parish Website contact tab for the email address.

Practice Update – Dr John Moloughney reported

- (a) Industrial Diagnostics were due to commence imminently.
- (b) Extended Access – Stratford is the nearest hub for Bidford patients.
- (c) There are no results as yet from the surgery survey.
- (d) Surgery Networks – the PPPG Update May 2019 had been circulated – this is an extract from that document - *“Item 1.1 Transforming General Practice Together – Networks*
The GP practices have been meeting together and attachment one shows the current configuration. The next steps for the new Primary Care Networks (PCN) are to submit their formal applications to the CCG by 15th May 2019. The application includes listing the member practices, the population and geographical area covered and naming the Accountable Clinical Officer (also referred to as Accountable Directors or Accountable Clinical Leads). The applications will be discussed at the CCG Governing Body on 22nd May 2019 and confirmation by the CCG is required by 30th May. The PCNs come into being on 1st July 2019”
 - a. Out of Hours Service – This item was also covered in the PPPG document circulated and below is an extract:” *Item 1.2 Out of Hospital Care Collaborative programme*
The Out of Hospital Care Collaborative (OOHCC) has now reached the end of year 1 of the 2 year transformational programme and the 3 year contract. In south Warwickshire we now have 3 Place Based Teams in Alcester, north and south Leamington. Progress has been made on the year one

pathways – diabetes, end of life and frailty and work has commenced on the year two pathways – heart failure and COPD. AC is coming to the May meeting and will provide a more detailed update. “

- (e) John reported that the Extended Access had been useful but not taken up as much as expected. Trinity Court, Alcester and Wellesborne had only had a 20% take-up. Bidford take up not been used but Saturday mornings were OK.
- (f) LB, the apprentice, is finishing and a second apprentice will soon be starting.
- (g) The Over 75 Plan is continuing.
- (h) Patient Access appointment were mentioned because appointments with doctors could not be made if routine nurse appointments were already booked – ie INR appointments. MF said he would take this up at the next PPPG meeting in July.

SWCCG – MF/WL

- a) Task & Finish – Maternity – WL circulated an update on this dated 2.5.19 (a copy is attached to these Minutes.
- b) Wax Removal Micro Suction – This was a further item mentioned on the PPPG Update May 19. Below is an extract: *“3.4.3 Micro-Suction - The procurement process for the implementation of a new community wax removal service has now been completed. There were 3 successful AQP providers; Specsavers, Industrial Diagnostics Company and Interhearing. The new services are going to be mobilised between May and June 2019. Patients will benefit from this service by being able to access wax removal services that were previously only available in hospital, closer to home “*
- c) MF mentioned the Strategic Commissioning Operation Plan.

Information Evenings

- (a) 15th May - Arthritis – There are at present 29 booked. Hopefully this will be another interesting evening. JJ and JT have asked for posters so they can advertise within his local community. WL will get these from Jon and email copies to them.
- (b) Banners – NC had sent quotes to Jon but at present it was agreed to leave for the time being.
- (c) Diabetes Evening agreed for 17th July 2019. The surgery would ask the nurses for assistance in planning this.
- (d) Young People’s Health had been mentioned in the Bidford report mentioned above so maybe this could be considered for a future evening.

- (a) WL and DL have been asked to give a short talk at the SCAN Meeting – Jolly Teapot, Thursday 25th July at 10.15 about the PPG should be an opportunity to bring the group to people’s attention.
